



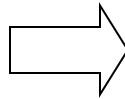

## **Connective Tissue Graft**



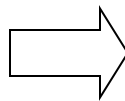
Tooth brush abrasion and root prominence. Cold sensitivity. Visible recession when smiling.



100% root coverage and tissue color harmony. No more sensitivity. Natural appearance when smiling.



Root prominence. Progressive recession due to lack of attached gingiva.



90+% root coverage (not 100% due to root prominence). CTG technique allowed for creation of thick and attached/keratinized tissue.

A Connective Tissue Graft is the gold standard for treating recession for root coverage and tissue color harmony. This surgical technique creates thicker more resilient tissue against the forces of chewing and oral hygiene.
