



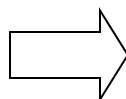

Free Gingival Graft



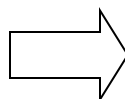
Progressive gum recession.
No attached tissue.
Irritated tissue due to plaque accumulation.



Only partial root coverage achieved due to root prominence. More importantly, a stable thick band of attached tissue is present. Good tissue health and easier to keep clean.



Progressive gum recession.
No attached/keratinized tissue.
Localized frenum tissue pull.



Root coverage achieved. Excellent band of attached tissue. Frenum pull eliminated. Good tissue health and easier to keep clean.

A Free Gingival Graft is the gold standard for creating thick and wide bands of keratinized and attached gingiva. Some root coverage can be achieved via creeping attachment. This technique best addresses lack of attached tissue, shallow vestibules, frenum pulls, and progressive recession.
